

First Single-handed Around the World non stop without assistance Non stop voyage around the world without assistance. Alessandro is 460 miles away from Di Benedetto the Canary Islands.

‘ Everything is all right on board , the automatic pilot is ok. I am sailing with free wind , a north wind under spi; this night I didn’t sleep in order to take advantage as much as possible from the wind and catch up the time I has lost at Cape Finisterre. My average speed is 6.5 knots with occasional bursts of 8 knots, which is a very respectable speed for a boat of that dimension and moreover loaded as it is right now’

Positive news sent this morning by Alessandro Di Benedetto.

The daring voyager who is trying to sail around the world on a 21 feet boat, was a little tired after a night spent steering , however full of enthusiasm and optimism.

‘ If it is going on like this, I will arrive at the level of the Canary Islands before the date I had imagined- two or three days earlier...’
